The Objective of the Paper: - To know the rulings concerning congregational prayer, Friday prayer, the prayer of the traveler, khauf, prayer of the sick. - To know the things that invalidate the prayer, how to perform it, to know the witr and fajr prayers, as well as tahiyyat al-masjid, kusoof, istisqaa, the two eid prayers, and the prostrations during the Quran. - To know the rulings concerning the dead, such as washing the dead, kafn, burial, as well as the funeral prayer.	
Learning Outcome: After the completion of this subject, the student will be able to: - Explain the fiqh rulings concerning the obligatory and supererogatory prayers (congregational, Friday, travellers, fear, sick, witr, fajr, kusoof, istisqaa), and correct his acts of worship by implementing rulings concerning it and be able to teach others - Perform necessary duties concerning the dead, such as washing, kafn, prayer upon it, burial, all based on shairyah. - Explain the reasons for differences between scholars, their methodologies when deducing rulings, how they weigh between proofs; as well grow his ability to deduce using the Islamic fiqh knowledge books.	
A Synopsis of the Paper: The rules of congregation prayer, imama, Friday prayer, prayers of travel and fear, prayer of the sick, things that invalidate the prayer, making up missed prayers, prostration for forgetfulness, optional prayers, prayers of eclipses and for rain, prostrations for recital, and rules concerning the dead.	
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
