In addition to the inclusion of the top 50 list of higher education system strength ranking, the website provides a one stop centre of information on each of the nation's university's availability and academic programs, application on fees and visa and so forth.

Malaysia recently as well occupies the ninth place among the world's best educational systems based on the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), in spite of the quality and effectiveness of the Malaysian education system, low range of tuition fees and living costs compared with the Western countries.
