SRC NOMINATION QUALIFICATION/ CRITERIA

- 1. Must have and maintain a 3.00 cumulative point average.
- 2. Proficient in two languages English and Arabic, and good in Bahasa is a bonus.
- 3. Aspire to be a leader and with leadership quality personality.
- 4. Student's who have never been found guilty, convicted or in pending of any disciplinary offence.
- 5. Students must have good physical, and mental health, high ethical values and good personality.
- 6. Be protective of the reputation of the University.
- 7. Fulltime registered student.

RULES OF GENERAL ELECTIONS

- 1. Candidates and supporters of the candidates are advised to comply with the rules and regulations. Any election irregularities or misconduct against Acts 174 during the period of the election campaign process should be addressed in writing to the Head of Election Commission.
- 2. The Election Commission has the rights to disqualify any of the candidates from the elections if he or she fails to follow any rules and regulations set by Election Commission.
- 3. If an election winner was found violating any election rules and regulation or the Act 174, the Election Commission has the right to revoke the election result.
- 4. The Election Commission has the rights to immediately disqualify a candidate if found to have violated any regulation or Act 174.
- 5. Candidates are strictly forbidden to involve outsiders (other than ITP students or any political party) in any kind of involvement during the election campaign. Disciplinary action will be taken against candidates who fail to follow this rule.
